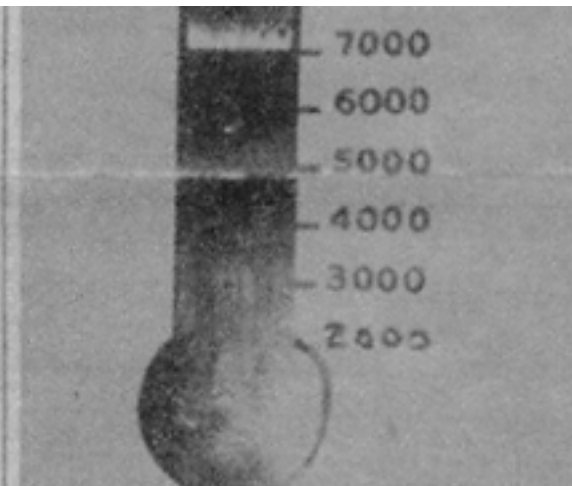

Hughs and 1st Lt. J. R. Calhoun.
